POSITION: Visiting Assistant Professor of History (Ancient/Medieval European and Pre-Modern World)

Required:

- Ph.D. in history, with specialty in Ancient/Medieval European and Pre-Modern World history, including Gender/Women's/Sexuality
- Ability to teach world civilization sequence
- Evidence of successful teaching at the undergraduate level
- Willingness and ability to teach general education courses as needed
- Willingness to support the mission of the College
- Continuing professional development

Preferred: -Experience at a liberal arts college

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Teach seven courses per year (3 in Fall, 3 in Winter, 1 in four-week May Term) in history and general education, including Inquiry Studies 101 Asking Questions, Making Choices
- Perform departmental and college service, including program assessment and new student recruitment

SALARY: Competitive for entry-level appointment

CONTRACT: Nine-month, term contract, renewable for up to two additional years
