Title of Position – Information Literacy and User Experience Librarian

Function of Position:

Collaborates with other librarians and faculty in the design and delivery of the library's information literacy program, including liaison and collection development duties. Provides leadership in expanding, enhancing and assessing the user experience at the Vogel Library.

Coordinates the library's student employment program. The nature and scope of the responsibilities for this position are expected to change as the library organization evolves. This position reports to the College Librarian.

Responsibilities:

- 1) Teach information literacy skills and concepts to support and enhance Wartburg's Information Literacy Across the Curriculum program. Creates and maintains teaching partnerships with classroom faculty and staff, foster mentoring relationships with students, and conducts liaison and collection duties as assigned, including for Journalism & Communication Arts, Business, and other selected areas. Provide general reference services with possible weekend or evening hours.
- 2) Enhance the user experience by incorporating user input into the design and delivery of library services, programs, outreach, technology, and facilities. Serve as coordinator for the Library's Student Advisory Board. Mentor students pursuing careers in library and information science.
- 3) Serve as coordinator of the Library's student employment program and supervisor for the Peer Research Assistant Program.
- 4) Participate in planning, assessment, training, and policy-making for the library.
- 5) Provide service to the college, as a titled faculty member and member of the Wartburg community, through academic advising, student recruitment, and committee membership; engage in professional research/scholarship related to libraries and to the teaching and learning environment.
- 6) Other related duties as required.
