Function of Position:

This is an interim position, responsible to the Director of Student Engagement for the remainder of the 2020-21 academic year. This position will work through collaborative efforts to meet institution need around campus programming and student engagement.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Advise the Entertainment ToKnight (ETK) programming group, in collaboration with the newly hired Assistant Director of Residential Life and Campus Programming Coordinator.
- 2. Provide leadership, support, and coordination to help ensure a unique range of student and campus activities that can meet the needs of a diverse campus community.
- 3. Serve as a resource to the Residential Life Department and the Director of Student Engagement with programming and outreach to the campus community during the continued COVID-19 pandemic.
- 4. Provide programming support and supervision of the Resident Assistant hired for the extended Christmas Break.

Supervision:

Employee proceeds independently, working toward established objectives, requiring the use of a wide range of procedures. Employee prioritizes own work and refers unusual cases to supervisor.

Minimum Qualifications:

Requires a Bachelor's Degree. Requires clear communication skills and desire to work with college-age students. Candidate must have an interest in campus programming and the development of a residential community. A positive and helpful attitude is required along with a willingness to work in a flexible environment, as a member of a hard-working team. Prefer experience working with diverse populations and in small college residence halls.
