- Serve as the primary academic advisor for Physical Education students. (15%)
 Assist with recruitment efforts for the department, including faculty, staff, and students. This could include participation in student visit days, scholarship days, Cedar Valley Science Symposium, and assisting with recruitment of qualified adjuncts to deliver courses within the PE major requiring specialized credentials. (10%)
