Function of Position:

The Assistant Director for Group Fitness is responsible to the Director of the Sports and Wellness Center for oversight of the all fitness programs and Social Media for the operation.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

1) Oversee group fitness program: hire, train, supervise, and evaluate student and community group fitness Instructors for land and water fitness classes

Design and implement new programming; maintain inventory and make necessary purchases of equipment for the program; perform routine maintenance of equipment; maintain a policies and procedures manual for the program; Market the fitness program to the entire community with an emphasis on reaching people of all ages and body types. 4) Maintain files for all part-time staff; fulfill necessary payroll duties to assure part-time staff, is correctly paid, also paid on time; maintain all necessary files for liability purposes; assist with development of department budget. (10%)

5) Assist with Personal Training as time allows staying abreast of all trends and industry standards. Maintain all necessary certifications for personal training. (10%)

6) Assist with professional coverage of the facility: this will include regular morning, evening and weekend shifts: assist with the development of departmental policies and procedure manual that governs all programs in the facility; assist with cross-training of Welcome Desk staff. (5%)

7) Perform other related duties as required. (5%)
