Title of Position – Clay Target Team Head Coach

Function of Position:

Responsible to the Director of Athletics for the development and oversight of the newly announced Clay Target Team, with competition beginning in Fall of 2020. A successful candidate will be responsible for the program operation, recruiting, practice and competition management.

Principle Duties and Responsibilities

1. Recruitment and retention of qualified student athletes
2. The organization and supervision of team practices;
3. Organization and supervision of athletes in collegiate competitions;
4. Management of the club's budget and fund raising;
5. Other duties within the College as assigned, based upon the qualifications of the candidate.

Qualifications

- Excellent working knowledge of shooting sports
- Must demonstrate excellent leadership, role-modeling, organizational and interpersonal skills; and effective teaching methods
- Previous coaching and recruitment experience
- Bachelor's degree required, Master's preferred
- Commitment to the welfare and development of student athletes within the philosophy of Division III
- Focus on risk management and safety
- Membership and/or network within the Scholastic Clay Target Program and the Iowa State Trapshooting Association.
