Student Support Services Fee \$2,300

This fee is used to support a variety of activities, including but not limited to student government, student activities, recreational opportunities, off-campus experiences, and other student support services (such as academic support, technology, facilities, and security).

Indemnity Deposit \$300

Refunded upon graduation or official withdrawal if unused for fines, damages, or other unpaid charges; billed once.

Room

Housing assignments are made by the Residential Life Office after students complete and return a housing application. All listed room costs are at least double occupancy. A limited number of single rooms are available for an additional charge.

Board

All students living in campus residences are required to have a board plan. Meal plans are charged at the full amount, with any unused points rolling from one term to the next, through May Term. Any unused points at the end of May Term are nonrefundable. A special six-meal plan applies only to Knights Village residents.
