

## **CLEP College Level Examination Program**

For enrichment or advancement, students may take examinations of the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and receive credit by achieving Wartburg's minimum quality score. Students may test any time during the academic year using computer based testing. For more information, visit: www.collegeboard.com/clep.

## Policies and Procedures:

SUBJECT CLEP EXAMS

- 1. A student who fails to achieve a minimum quality score in a CLEP exam may retake it three months after the initial exam.
- 2. A student who fails to earn credit in a course which is equivalent to a CLEP exam must wait four months following completion of/withdrawal from that course before taking the equivalent CLEP.
- 3. If a student is enrolled in a course and classes have begun, a student may not attempt the CLEP exam that is equivalent to that course.
- 4. A student who has already earned a passing grade in a course may not attempt the CLEP exam to replace the grade in that course.
- 5. A student may not take a CLEP exam in a prerequisite course while in the process of taking, or if they have been enrolled in, a course at the next level in a sequential course series.
- 6. Twelve course credits is the maximum amount of credit by examination which may be applied toward graduation. This includes CLEP, Challenge, and AP exams.
- 7. Students who wish to transfer CLEP exam credit to/from another institution must request an official score report from the Educational Testing Service (800-257-9558) to be sent to the Registrar's Office of the school to which they are transferring.
